


How to connect to SSL VPN (Sonic Wall Net Extender)

1. Open **Internet Explorer**.
2. In the Internet Explorer address bar, type **<https://mail.efficienthomellc.com:4433>** and hit enter.
3. Click on "**Continue to this website (not recommended)**"



4. Once you see the Virtual Office login screen, follow the steps below to add the address to your trusted sites list. Once added, the page will reload.

Instructions to add the SSL-VPN web address into the browser's trusted sites list.

Step 1 - Click the **Internet Options** item from IE **Tools** menu.

Step 2 - Click **Security** tab in Internet Options window, select **Trusted sites** from list, then click **Sites** button.

Step 3 - Add the SSL-VPN server address to the list.

Step 4 - Make sure that **Enable Protected Mode** is **NOT** checked in Internet Options window, then click **OK** button to proceed.

5. **Enter the user name and password** that you would normally use to connect to the VPN (or log into your office computer). **NOTE:** passwords are case-sensitive.




6. Once logged in, you will see the following screen. Click on the **NetExtender** icon.



7. If this is your first time using NetExtender, you may be prompted to **install an add-on**. Click on “**Install**” as prompted. If you receive a **User Access Control** prompt, click “**Yes**” to allow the installation.



8. After installation or after clicking the Net Extender icon, the following pop-up displays. You now have a secure connection to the office and can access the server as you normally would.



9. Once you are finished, be sure to press the **“Disconnect”** button to close the connection.
NOTE: Not disconnecting properly may prevent others from establishing a connection.
10. To reconnect to the SSL VPN, double-click the **NetExtender icon in the taskbar** or right-click on the icon and select **“Connect”**. Then, **enter your username and password and click “Connect”**. Verify that the pop up reads "Connected".

NOTE: If the **Server** and **Domain** fields are blank, enter the details in the image below.
